### March 2021 Update

We hope you are all staying safe and warm as we inch ever closer to spring. We've continued to be busy over the last few months. As you may know, our community skating rink has been open since November and has been well used by community league members. There have been some reports of overcrowding on the rink and as always, we encourage everyone to adhere to 10 skater capacity limit and to wear a mask whenever possible. The rink is financially supported by those who have purchased Meadowlark Community League memberships, however in addition to those funds we also were successful in receiving over \$9,000 from the Edmonton Oilers Community Foundation for rink operations this year. A big thank you to the EOCM for their support!

We've also been actively working on repairing the roof at the Meadowlark Community League Building. We've had a number of leaks over the years and repairing the roof has been long overdue and we are very happy that it has now been completed. The repairs were made possible through grant funds from the Community Facility Enhancement Program (CFEP). Additionally, with the roof repairs coming under budget, we've also upgraded the building's electrical panels which will address some of the issues we've had this year in keeping the lights on at the community rink in the evenings. Thanks to JRM Electrical Contractors for their work on the electrical panel and A. Clark Roofing & Siding for the roof repairs!

I'd also like to thank those who participated in our "16 Days of Meadowlark" Christmas Scavenger Hunt. We loved seeing people getting out and checking out the holiday decorations in our community. I hope you all enjoy your gift cards!

## **Waste Collection Changes**

# Support Local Business



The way that we sort, set out and collect waste in our neighbourhood is changing. The City of Edmonton will provide all single-unit and some multi-unit homes with a garbage cart, food scraps cart and a food scraps pail between March—August 2021.

This new system will include four collection services:

- 1. **Food Scraps**—collected weekly from spring-fall and every 2 weeks in winter, using the provided cart.
- 2. **Recycling**—collected in blue bags year-round on a weekly basis (no change)
- 3. **Garbage**—collected every 2 weeks year-round, using the provided cart.
- 4. **Yard Waste**—collected twice in the Spring and twice in the Fall in clear plastic bags or double-ply paper yard waste bags and/or bundles wrapped in biodegradable twine.






## **Electric Vehicles (EVs)**

# **Community Kitchen/Grill**

Did you know that there are a number of programs that are available to help offset the cost of purchasing an electric vehicle (EV) or plug-in hybrid electric vehicle (PHEV) as your next vehicle purchase?



The Government of Canada provides up to \$5,000 for electric vehicles and long-range, plug-in hybrid vehicles and up to \$2,500 towards the purchase of a short-range, plug-in hybrid electric vehicle.
Additionally, eligible businesses can access a tax write-off for the costs of purchasing an EV or PHEV. More details can be found on the Government of Canada website:

Additionally, the City of Edmonton is offering a rebate to help Edmonton businesses and homeowners install an electric vehicle charging station on their property. This program can cover up to 50% of the costs for the purchase and installation of Level 2 charging stations to a maximum of \$600 for residential properties, and \$2,000 for commercial properties. Funds are limited and applications will be accepted until May 31, 2021 or until all funds for this year are expended. More details on the program can be found below:

### Mediterranean Feta Burgers with Lemony Feta **Spread**

### Ingredients:

### Burger:

1 lb ground beef

1 egg

Scant ¼ cup breadcrumbs 1/3 cup finely chopped

parsley

1½ tbsp minced fresh dill

1 tsp dry oregano

½ tsp salt

1/4 tsp ground pepper

1/4 tsp cayenne pepper

1/4 tsp cumin

1/4 roughly chopped feta

cheese

### Lemony Feta Spread:

34 cup mayonnaise

1/₃ cup chopped feta cheese

1 tbsp fresh dill

1-2 tsp lemon juice (to taste)

1 tsp lemon zest

½ - 1 tsp minced garlic (to

taste)

#### Other:

Hamburger buns Red onions cut into rings Sliced Roma tomatoes

### **Directions:**

Whisk egg in a small bowl. Add egg, along with all other burger ingredients to a large bowl and mix well with your hands until all ingredients are incorporated. Form into 4 burger patties.

To make spread—put all ingredients in a food processor (or blender) and blend until mixture has the consistency of chunky peanut butter (mainly smooth, with small bits of feta visible).

Grill burgers on a prepared grill. Toast buns when burgers are close to done. Serve burgers with a good spoonful of lemony feta spread on bottom bun, topped with sliced tomato and fresh red onion rings. Enjoy!
