1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

General

The community league is registered under the Societies Act of Alberta for the purpose of coordinating recreational activity within its community.

Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are stated at cost and reflect the position as at February 28, 1981.

All subsequent capital expenditures have been expensed in the year acquired.

No depreciation has been reflected in these financial statements.

Income Tax Status

The community league is a registered charity within the meaning of the Income Tax Act (Canada) and is exempt from income taxes.

4. MEADOWLARK BUCKS

When a Meadowlark Community League (MCL) member assists in the operation of a MCL sponsored casino he or she is issued Meadowlark Bucks with a value of up to \$60.00. Meadowlark Bucks can be used to reduce the normal fee for sports and programs offered by the community league or City of Edmonton programs. The fee may be reduced by up to 75% through the use of the bucks. If not used, the bucks expire one year from December 31st of the year of their issue.

Meadowlark Bucks redeemed for Sports, Programs, and City of Edmonton and affiliated community league programs were: \$300.
